- Aelod o awdurdod lleol o fewn ardal Heddlu Gwent.
- Pobl nad ydyn nhw'n byw nac yn gweithio yn ardal Heddlu Gwent.
- Gweision sifil yn cymryd rhan mewn gweithgaredd gwleidyddol.

Mae gan Aelodau Annibynnol yr hawl i gael costau teithio a lwfans presenoldeb o £105 am hanner diwrnod a £210 am ddiwrnod llawn. Bydd taliadau yn cael eu gwneud am amser mewn cyfarfodydd yn unig ac maen nhw'n cynnwys amser paratoi a theithio. Mae tua 6 chyfarfod y flwyddyn.

Gwent Police and Crime Panel Appointment of 1 Independent Members

The Gwent Police and Crime Panel is seeking to appoint an Independent Members. The Panel is an independent public body made up of 12 Councillors (nominated by the 5 Gwent Local Authorities) and 2 Independent Members. The panel was established in accordance with the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 and its role is to support and challenge the Gwent Police and Crime Commissioner.

This appointment is to fill a vacancy that has arisen due to the resignation of one of the co-opted members and will be made until the current term ends on 31st October 2024.

Applicants for the independent member roles must not be:

- Anyone under 18 years old.
- A member of staff of the Gwent Police and Crime Commissioner.
- A serving Police Officer.
- A member of the civilian staff for Gwent Police.
- A Member of Parliament.
- Members of the Senedd or Scottish Parliament.
- A Member of a local authority within the Gwent Police area.
- Persons who do not live or work in the Gwent Police force area.
- Civil servants engaged in political activity.

Independent Members are entitled to receive travelling expenses and an attendance allowance of £105 half day and £210 full day. Payments are made for meeting time only and are inclusive of preparation time and travelling. There are approximately 6 meetings per annum.
